Enrollment Center

All services related to the enrollment of students in Transitional Kindergarten through 8th grade are provided in the Moorpark Unified Enrollment Center. The center is located at 5297 Maureen Lane and will be open from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday effective January 24, 2017. Hours are subject to change; please check the district website.

The enrollment center welcomes all families who are enrolling a child new to the district in Transitional Kindergarten through 8th grade. *New high school students should register at Moorpark High School.

We will also accept applications for School of Distinction transfers if you are interested in having your child attend a school other than your neighborhood school, whether you live within the MUSD area or are considering an interdistrict transfer. The application for Schools of Distinction will be available January 24 and will be accepted no later than February 17. You will be notified of the status of your transfer application by March 17, 2017.

Reservations are not needed to attend Information Nights or School Tours.

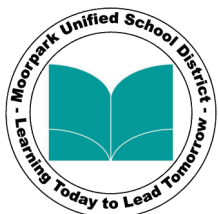
